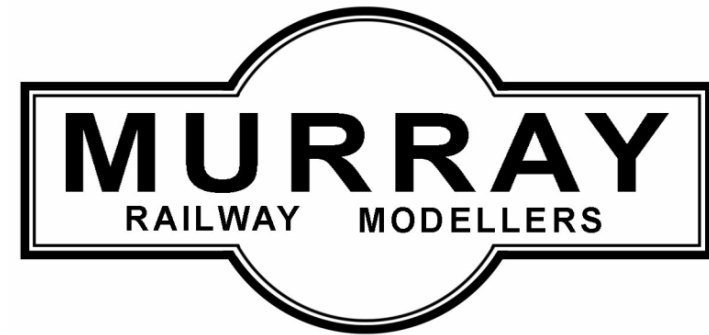

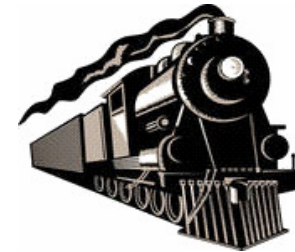

**Stand 11 - Ettamogah - HO - Peter Allen**

Ettamogah is based on the new freight terminal at Tabletop 10 km North of Albury on the main standard gauge line between Melbourne and Sydney. The freight terminal is unique in that it has the only two Cargo Sprinters in Australia. These two units perform the daily shunting duties. Ettamogah Rail Hub is a leading edge regional intermodal transport facility established to provide an important link between multi-modal terminals across Australia. The Rail Hub is in its early stages with further development planned. The Hub has its own rail sidings, a 300 metre concrete platform and a 320 metre gravel platform and can accommodate trains up to 1200 metres in length. The layout shows the Griffith Train dropping off and picking up its wagons, The Cargo Sprinters shunting the wagons, and a selection of other trains likely to be seen passing the Freight Terminal. It is still a work in progress but is completed enough to give a good indication of daily activity at the Rail Hub.

**Stand 12 - Leopold– HO – Sunbury Model Railway Club**

This layout depicts a small through station on a branch line somewhere in Victoria. Typical branch line trains of the 1960’s and 70’s can be seen running on the line. The layout was refurbished a few years ago with additional buildings and enhanced scenery. It has recently been extended but still maintains the feel and simplicity established by the builder, Ray Leopold, a founding member of the Club nearly 30 years ago.
